Greetings from Uganda!

This last year has been a glorious year here in Uganda. I continue to work with Pastor Gerald Walusimbi, JWTL Ministries International, and the International School of Christian Growth (ISCG).

It is a blessing being a part of this ministry. In the last two years it has continued to grow and thrive!

As part of the ISCG program, our Kampala students in levels 4 & 5 are required to participate in a mission trip. They do door-to-door evangelism, pray for the people they meet, share the gospel and invite them to be a part of the ISCG Bible College where they live.

In 2016-2017 the students went on missions trips to Bulissa, Jinja, Gulu, **Nakeseke**, Masindi, Mbaarara, Lira, Kayunga, **Kiisi Kenya** and Kigali Rwanda.

They ministered to 30,261 people and of those 3,682 committed their hearts to Jesus. Praise God!

The program has been such a success we will be establishing extensions schools in both Kenya and Rwanda this year.

Through our continued surrender to Him, God is on the move ever expanding His kingdom in this amazing nation among these beautiful brother's and sisters in Christ. I am so blessed to be a part of this!

In the picture above, we are in **Kiisi Kenya** standing on the property that we have been given to open a new ISCG location. The property has two houses, a school, and land to plant crops. God has already expanded our vision for this location. Not only will our ISCG classes meet on this property, but we will use the school building to start a bible based primary school as well. We have already met with 16 of the local leaders of the Pentecostal Assemblies of God churches who will be working with us to start an ISCG in Kiisi.

We were also given land in **Nakeseke**. This will be our permanent home for our ISCG school and we started a church here as well. We were able to purchase additional land adjacent to the property where we have constructed a concrete and brick pit latrine. This is a luxury! Two of our ISCG graduates are permanently in **Nakeseke** pastoring the Church and teaching at the school.

Other than Kenya & Rwanda all of our outreaches had medical camps with doctors and nurses treating the sick. As is often the case, many people were prayed for and received their healing before receiving medical attention.

Thirty five of these people were in critical condition and all of them survived. As well as prayer, we were able to pay a year's worth of medical insurance for 50 people to give them access to medical treatment anytime they need it.

I have partnered with Jennifer Echong a CBC Uganda graduate in her ministry in Mulago Hospital. Jennifer has started discipleship groups among the nurses and doctors and she ministers and prays for hundreds of people each year. Jennifer sees many healings and salvations among the patients she prays for.
