of A Great Door Ministries and leader of our Cambodia projects just kept shaking his head as he told us that the people of Poup

Boung & Chreas Provinces simply have no words to express how deeply thankful they are for the wells that were placed in their villages bringing life saving, health giving, fresh clean water to them. No longer will they have to drink from bacteria infested mud holes, wondering what they are going to do when the rain doesn't come to refill the hole.

The ground was so dry where these wells were placed that the 2nd well had to be driven down 100 ft. before it reached water.

**Rice, Blankets, & Mosquito Nets Distributed**

Along with the two wells that were placed in Poup Boung and Chreas Province we also distributed 4,000 pounds of rice, 40 blankets, and 60 mosquito nets.
