Greetings from Uganda!

I have been reflecting on all of the glorious adventures I have experienced since I first arrived here in June 2008. It has been an amazing experience and I have watched God do awesome things. I have had the blessing of being able to love, support, teach and empower many through the grace of God and your support. I am so grateful for all that God is doing here.

I have watched God connect me with amazing Ugandan nationals, former CBC Uganda students of mine and others that I have been able to mentor and disciple. I have worked closely with Gerald Walusimbi of JWTL Ministries, The International School of Christian Growth (ISCG) and Jesus Christ Church (JCC). I first met Gerald when he came to me and asked me to be his "spiritual Mom." He said he saw me in a vision and God told him to connect with me. We have been together ever since.

Currently there are 2,192 students attending ISCG throughout Uganda. Through outreach and mission trips with our students we hold medical camps, minister in prisons and hospitals and reach out to communities sharing "The Gospel", food, clothing and the unconditional love of God.



Disciples making Disciples!

Our students go door-to-door sharing the good news, praying for salvations, healings, baptism in the Holy Spirit and any other needs. On average we touch over 15,000 lives "one on one" each year. In 2018 we touched 21,848 lives with 3,282 people receiving Jesus as their Lord & Savior.

We have also begun work in Kenya, Rwanda and Malawi. In December a team of 28 of our leaders opened Jesus Christ Church International and International School of Christian Growth in Malawi on property that was gifted to us. Glory to God!

I have also had the privilege of working with and supporting Robina Bukenya these last 10 years. Robina has a heart for children, widows and prisoners. The work in Remand and Luzira prisons continues. The 5 children that we adopted, whose parents are indefinitely in prison, are thriving.

Another one of my former students, Jennifer Echong, who I partner with and support is continuing her ministry in the Kampala hospitals. Jennifer has a powerful testimony of being healed from polio. When I first met Jennifer she was unable to walk but after prayer she was healed and has been walking and seeing thousands of salvations and healings through her ministry. With my help Jennifer has also set up discipleship classes with hospital staff at Mulago Hospital.



I recently started working with Baptist Emochu. Baptist has a church called, "Emphanizo" which means "Christ Manifested." I have been teaching at his church and he has asked me to mentor/disciple him and to help him set up a bible school.

He has a group of young people that are hungry for a deeper relationship with God and they want to be able to minister to others. After teaching there I had the privilege of praying for each of them individually. I was so blessed!

I have also been able to pay school fees for children in my neighborhood and start some young people in business. I helped Aggie start a hair salon business and she now employs two other young ladies. I support Betty in her cleaning business and Innocent in his car for hire business.
